2010 Joan M. Weldon Memorial Scholarship Fund

About Joan

Joan Weldon was an active member of the Philadelphia Association of Paralegals (PAP) advocating on behalf of paralegals everywhere. She was elected President of PAP in 1991 and was instrumental in forming an alliance with the Philadelphia Bar Association.

Unfortunately, Joan was diagnosed with ovarian cancer towards the end of her presidency. As a testament to her character, she continued to work as a paralegal for Blank, Rome, Comisky & McCauley while undergoing treatment. In an effort to save her life, Joan's doctors recommended bone marrow and stem cell transplant procedures. However, her insurance carrier denied payment of the bills claiming the treatment was too experimental.



As a result, the legal community jumped into action. Members of the Association, other paralegals and Joan's employers initiated a media blitz to raise funds for her expensive medical care. She appeared on Wally Kennedy's morning show and an article was published in the Philadelphia Inquirer by acclaimed author, Steve Lopez ("*The Soloist*"). Within 2 weeks, approximately \$80,000 was raised.

The insurance company reevaluated its decision and ultimately paid Joan's medical bills. The donations were placed into the Paralegal Medical Assistance Fund to help other Philadelphia paralegals with burdensome medical expenses.

Sadly, Joan passed away on Christmas Day in 1994. Although she is still sorely missed, the annual Joan Weldon Memorial Scholarship Fund lives on in her memory.

About the JWM Scholarship

The Joan Weldon Memorial Scholarship is an annual \$1,000 award, from the Philadelphia Association of Paralegals, given to a paralegal student demonstrating academic excellence and exceptional community service. The winner is selected by members of the Professional Development Committee. The award is presented at the Association's Bi-Monthly Luncheon in July during Paralegal Week.

Applications are available on the Association's website as of February 1, 2010. **All applications must be postmarked by June 4, 2010.** Certain restrictions and requirements apply. See Instruction Sheet for details.

2010 JOAN WELDON SCHOLARSHIP FUND (APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS)

Who is Eligible: Students demonstrating academic excellence *and* exceptional community service while enrolled in paralegal studies program within the Delaware Valley area.

Scholarship Amount: \$1,000.00 (Proceeds made payable to the student)

Instructions: (3 page *maximum*; double spaced; 12 pt font; Times New Roman/Arial **ONLY**)

1. Submit an essay incorporating **all** of the following topics:
 - a. Why, as part of a paralegal career, you should join and participate in your professional paralegal association? Why is it important?
 - b. Looking ahead, discuss the future of the paralegal profession.
 - c. Why is continuing education important?

NOTE: Be sure to include statements about your academic success, work/internship experience and community service. Include your participation in the Philadelphia Association of Paralegals, if any.

2. Complete the attached Contact Information/Certification of Attendance Form and return it with your essay.
3. Submit one (1) letter of recommendation confirming your participation in a community service activity. *Official letterhead required.*

Submission Deadline: All applications must ***be postmarked by Friday, June 4, 2010.*** No exceptions!
